

## **LMFSC BUY-ON POLICY 2010 – 2011 Contract Season**

This Buy-On policy is in effect with the first session of each LMFSC skating season.

### **Buy-On Charges**

Any LMFSC member skater will be allowed to charge Buy-On ice with parent permission. The Buy-On Authorization form is attached to the Ice Contract. A list of these skaters is posted in the LMFSC Ice Monitor book. ***Only those skaters that the parent has given written authorization will be listed, and allowed to charge Buy-Ons.***

Any parent wishing to give permission after the Ice Contracts are initially sent in may request an additional contract to sign for Buy-On charge permission.

Each time a skater Buys-On ice, the Ice Monitor will list the skater's name on the sheet for the applicable date and ice sessions in the Ice Monitor book. These charges will be added to the next ice billing statement.

LMFSC Home Club members have priority over Associate members for buying onto a session. LMFSC Home Club members and Associate members will have priority over non-LMFSC skaters for buying onto a session.

### **New this year**

Pre-Purchase buy on sessions for the 2010-2011 season. Purchase 6 buy-on sessions for \$75.00 (6 hours for the price of 5 hours). Sessions are good on those available for buy-on during the 2010-2011 season only.

### **Selling Ice**

For the 2010-2011 skating season, selling of ice by a skater will only be allowed on sessions with 20 or more skaters. When a skater sells ice, the skater will be credited with the dollar amount for the session that was paid in accordance with the Ice Contract, on the next ice statement. The additional Buy-On amount goes to LMFSC.

Buy-On charges are in accordance with the current skating season's ice charges for 3 levels – LMFSC Home Club Member, LMFSC Associate Member and non-LMFSC member (must be a U.S. Figure Skating member).
